

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

1. Congratulations! You've enrolled your child because you've dreamed him/her to achieve big and be counted among young achievers. We expect your enthusiasm throughout the sessions as well as competitions (if participating/eligible).
2. Once enrolled in a team, team members are required to attend mentoring sessions without fail. In case a member missed 2 consecutive sessions without prior permission from the mentor, he / she will be released from the team and payment made if any, will not be reimbursed.
3. Mentor's efforts and time are FREE OF CHARGE and he will be compensated by 51% ownership of shares and listed as co- inventor in case the innovation is patented and a company is floated to commercialize the innovation. The rest 49% of stake is to be evenly distributed among team members.
4. Payment is to cover the incidental expenses like Provisional Patent Application, Scholarship Fund, Logistics, Conveyance, Venue, Materials for prototype, Mentor's travel costs, etc. during the entire mentoring and competition.
5. When a team is selected to attend any competition and needs to travel, it is the responsibility of team member's guardian to make their own flight, lodging and boarding arrangements, unless the team is sponsored by any sponsor in which case only that part of cost will be borne by sponsors and unsponsored expense will be taken care by parents. The cost does NOT include travel for competitions.
6. Any team member, their parents or any other individual directly or indirectly related to them should NOT divulge any information on any media platform or interact with media, any other organization without prior approval from mentor. Since we will work on innovation, it'll have adverse effect in obtaining patent later and also risk the IP being breached.
7. While we mentor kids to be an innovator and apply for patents with a possibility of its commercialization, and also participate and win international student's competition, the enrollment for mentorship in no way guarantees participation or success in any competition. It depends on lots of parameters like student's performance on stage in front of judges, quality of other teams etc. Participation in competitions is purely an optional by-product of this program and depends at the discretion of mentor, availability of right competition for kid's age range and team's preparation for that competition.
8. Patents are granted from respective Patent Offices of the countries we decide to file (USPTO in US). Mentor or anyone from DiscoverSTEM team has absolutely no control over grant of patent. This mentorship in no way guarantees grant of patent, which sometimes takes 3 years or more by patent offices.
9. Sessions are normally conducted in class or through teleconference. While we try to accommodate everyone's availability and convenience, we cannot always do so and hence participant's cooperation is expected.
10. In case of any dispute, both parents and mentor agrees to arbitrate among themselves in good faith. In case the dispute is not resolved, mentor's liability is limited to reimbursing the registration fee paid after deducting the cost on pro-rata basis and parent may withdraw their child from the program thereafter
11. Many a times it is observed that a child is enrolled and rides on other team member's efforts without giving their reasonable best to the program. They end up owning patents, participating in various competitions without actually working for it. If that situation arises, mentor takes feedback from team members and also relies on his own observation. If it is found that a child is not interested in the program or not contributing in a reasonable manner, mentor reserves the right to withdraw a child from program and will reimburse the registration fee paid after deducting the cost on pro-rata basis
12. The mentorship is completely FREE, however for the program to be self-sustainable, parents are required to bear only the COST involved in the entire process AND a small contributions towards those bright kids who cannot afford (and in respect of mentor's FREE efforts and time for your child). If the allotted funds are not utilized, it'll be used as scholarship funds for next year deserving kids. If your kid is in need of scholarship, we welcome him to attend information session and mention that in registration form. We normally offer scholarship to kids whose parent's combined income is <\$30/hr.

Total cost is \$2000 (see breakdown below) which is to be paid at registration. You may choose pay in one go or various **post-dated checks** as explained in point #13 below.

- Cost of filing provisional patents, technology, components & external consulting (\$1200/child as filing patent is very costly)
 - Mentor's Travel, Conveyance, Venue & Miscellaneous Cost (\$300/child – mentor will travel from Irving, TX at least twice every month)
 - Scholarship fund for those who cannot afford (every year almost 50% of kids are on mentor's tab - \$500/child)
13. Payment Terms: We're very lenient on reimbursement of mentoring cost as per your convenience. You may choose to pay in any of the following ways through **post-dated checks** spread over 10 months of mentoring: 1 check of \$2000 2 checks of \$1000 4 checks of \$500 1 check of \$1000 and 10 check of \$100 each. 1 check of \$500 and 10 check of \$150 each (**tick one**)
